## Intensive Swimming Scheme

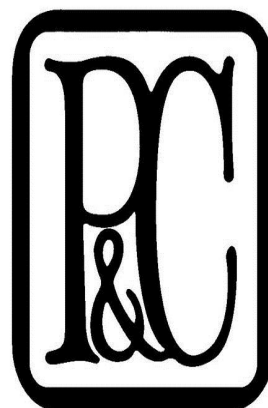
Our Intensive Swimming Scheme for 2013 commences on 11th November at Singleton Gym and Swim.
