Achieve With Pride

Yesterday Ms Adams and I attended an information session on Nationally Consistent Collection of Data on School Students with Disability which is an Australian wide process of data collection that will be mandatory for all schools in 2015. Most schools are using 2014 as a practise year to trial processes for both collecting, recording and reporting this data.

Names of students and school will be protected from public scrutiny. The data collection will then drive services, support, training and development and funding for schools and areas.

This will be to ensure all students in all schools have equity in their access to education.

Although the term 'disability' can concern some, it can be thought of as a wider range of everyday problems that may hinder learning—need glasses, broken bones, wheel chair need, behavioural challenges, social challenges as well as those serious physical and neurological needs.

A letter will soon be sent home asking your permission to allow us to include any data that may relate to your child, now or in the future (if arm is in plaster for ten weeks + and we need to make adjustments to the way the child learns in that period we need to record those adjustments) in the national data collection.

Aspects of student learning will be collected and recorded on a school level but won't be included in the national collection without parent permission. Data only will be utilised in the collection not student names.

The letter has an 'opt out' section which you would ignore if you are agreeable to having your child's data (if any) included in the national collection.

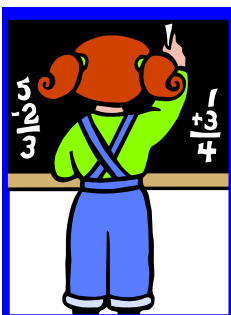


Parent/Carer Volunteers
