We had two teams represent our school at the St Catherine's Netball Gala Day last Friday.

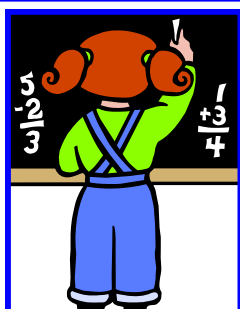
The Open Mixed Team demonstrated great sportsmanship in the four games they played, which was noted by their opposing teams and they were congratulated on their behaviour.

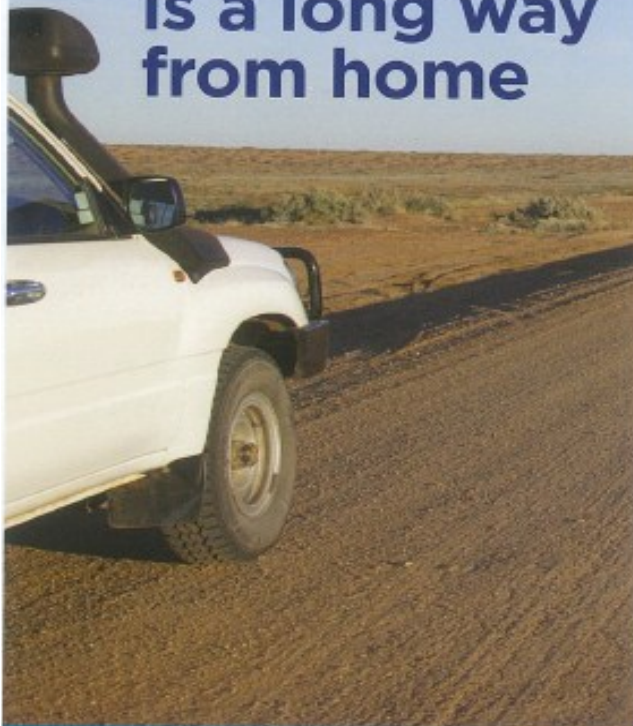
