Children travelling home on the school bus must wait under the shelter next to the sports storeroom.



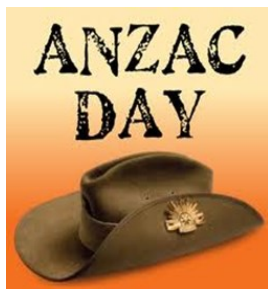
All other children must be collected by an adult.

The simplest way
